## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Demonstrate friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and forming good relationships with their peers and familiar adults.
- Be more outgoing towards unfamiliar people and become more confident in new social situations
- Begin to accept the needs of others and can take turns and share resources, sometimes with support from others

## Communication and Language:

- Key Texts 'It's Great to Share' and 'When I Grow Up'. 'It's Great to be Kind' and 'You and Me Always'. 'It's Great to Keep Calm' and 'A Moment Like This'.
- Listen to others one to one or in small groups, when the conversation interests them.
- Respond to simple instructions, e.g. to get or put away an object.
- Build up their vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences.

# **Physical Development:**

- Move freely and with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways, such as slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping.
