Spelling: We will be exploring words each week that related to the phonemes, diagraphs or spelling rules they are learning and practicing in phonics. These will be practiced in phonics and through fun spelling related activities that they will have access each week.

Maths: This year we will be following the White Rose maths scheme. This term in maths we will covering properties of 3D shapes, length and height, position and directions and mass and capacity.

Science: In science over the summer term we will be first looking at plants and learning to identify and describe the basic structure of plants and observing how they grow and what effects their growth. Then we will look at Animals including humans, learning about their basic needs, noticing that animals, including humans have offspring which grown into adults and the importance of exercise, eating healthy and hygiene.

Religious Education: Over this term Easdon will be exploring the themes 'Who is a Muslim and how do they live?' and 'What makes some places sacred for believers?'.

Computing: This terms ICT will be continuing to look at E-safety and being able to use application such as word and search ending efficiently. We will also continue looking at Coding using Scratch Jr.

Physical Education: PE will be led by Mr Peirce on a Tuesday morning and Mrs Sutton on Wednesdays.

We will first be focussing on Henri Rousseau learning about his art work and bringing these skills into our Art. After half term we will then be looking at 'Animal art'. Easdon will explore artwork from different cultures that portray animals in different ways.
